Volunteer Management Team

- 6) Supported Ashraya Seva Trust, **an old age home** with medicinal requirements of 9000/- for 2 months with volunteer contributions






College Relations

- 5) Google forms created in 9 languages to collect information from the students seeking assistance

Aalamban Need Assessment details

- 1) Total Registrations received 1,022 till 30th June 2021
- 2) 73 Volunteers doing Need Assessment of 801 students
- 3) Orientation conducted for Corporate Volunteers (43 of them are active)
- 4) Orientation conducted for 10 Tamil & 14 Telugu speaking volunteers
- 5) 5 student beneficiaries from MG Gadad program doing Need Assessment as volunteers
- 6) Kannada Registration 34 assessment done, 23 selected
- 7) English Registration 18 assessment done, 17 selected
